1. Presentation

1.1. Introduction

This tutorial is intended for all e-merchants who have the module "Partial Shipment (remaining order)" for PrestaShop in version 1.5.x to 1.7.x.

1.2. Module description

The most advanced and advanced module for managing your partial shipments and remaining orders. Keep inform your customers in real time and improved your customer satisfaction.

All e-merchants are faced with the problem of partial shipment or the management of remaining order. PrestaShop does not manage this natively and that is why our team has developed such a module.

Everyone is confronted with the problem of stock shortage on an order, so it is necessary to deliver the products available as quickly as possible in order to improve customer satisfaction.

My customer orders a product A and a product B. Unfortunately, the product B is no longer available and requires a replenishment. It becomes essential for the e-merchant to honor and make available the product A which is in stock.

Let's not forget that a satisfied customer is a customer who will come back to your e-commerce site!

1.3. What this product does for you

Which merchant did not face multiple delivery or partial order delivery during sales, Christmas or just daily periods?

You wish to ship your order in several times due to weight constraints for example? One of your products is no longer available to deliver the entire order?

Do not wait for your supplier replenishment to deliver your entire order. Our module has been designed to perform these actions very simply and effectively. Whether you are doing B2C or B2B, our module will be adapted to your needs and for each of your orders.

Today you will certainly have noticed, e-commerce does not wait and your customers either.

Our module will allow you to:

- Increase customer satisfaction by delivering products available in stock
- Facilitate the management of your service
- Keep your delivery commitments for all or part of your orders
- Simply and efficiently manage your remaining orders
- Generate an invoice per shipment for your B2B customers
- Choose whether or not to generate a rest of order
- Achieve as many partial deliveries as you want for a single order
- Inform your customers in real time when their order is shipped partially (A delivery note is sent as an attachment with the products shipped)
- Offer your customer access to information from his account and thus follow the parcels related to his order
- Save time in logistics management

Our team developed this module following a very simple observation: it is no longer conceivable to block an order because it lacks a product. We are supported by examples of major players in e-commerce such as AMAZON, CDISCOUNT ... for whom any product shipped becomes a problem less.

With this in mind, it became clear to us that a successful partial delivery module (order backlog) would allow even the smallest e-merchant to manage this problem simply and effectively.

1.4. Module features

This module of partial shipment / remaining order is the most advanced module to manage effectively this problem. Our module is ahead of these competitors and has many advantages:

INTUITIVE CONFIGURATION

- Installation in just a few clicks
- Simple and intuitive configuration
- Allows you to configure default values that you can then change for each partial shipment

COMPATIBLE WITH CARRIER MODULES

- Our module is perfectly compatible with carrier modules. Caution if you want to edit several labels, it will necessarily be necessary to generate order balances in order to be able to print a carrier label per order.
- Integrates the tracking numbers and sends an email to the customer containing the tracking number as well as the associated delivery note
- Allows you to generate or not generate order balances. Indeed, you may want to simply create a multiple delivery without generating backorders

- Allows you to stop waiting for a product to start shipping your order.
- Your customer is kept informed in real time of the partial shipment of his order
- · Display of front office delivery information in your customer's order interface

INTERFACE BACK OFFICE OPTIMIZED

- · The back office interface is intuitive and includes delivery information
- · Find each delivery note associated with the order
- In the case of creation of residual orders

ADAPT TO ALL SITES

- Our module adapts whatever the size of your e-commerce site

2. Installation

Different installation modes are available. This is generic to all PrestaShop modules, there are always two installation modes.

Via FTP by copying the directory or from the PrestaShop interface.

2.1. Copying files

2.1.1. Via FTP (File Tranfert Protocol)

Copy the "btpartialshipent" folder to the "/ modules" directory of your PrestaShop store.

Use a Filezilla tool for file transfers. Download and Documentation: http://filezilla-project.org/

2.1.2. Via your PrestaShop Back-Office

Check with your network administrator beforehand that your directory "/ modules" has good rights for uploading files.

Click "Add Module" (top right), select your file, then click "Put this module online".

2.2. Installing the module

Once the files are installed on your server, connect to the PrestaShop Back-Office and click on the "Modules" tab. You can also find the module by entering its name "Partial shipment" in the search bar provided.


On the modules page, click on the "Install" button to the right of the "Partial Shipment" module.

If the module is installed correctly, you will see a green message "Module (s) installed successfully".

You can then access the module's control panel by simply clicking on "Configure".




During the installation our module will create three new command statuses as follows:



3. Configuration

The Partial shipment module contains a "Configuration" tab in which we find the various elements of the configuration.

3.1. global configuration



Send an email	Allows you to determine whether you want to send an email to your customer whenever you perform a partial sihpment on one of these orders.		
New status (Partial shipment)	If you do not want to make a residue we propose to place partially delivered orders in the partially shipped status.		
New status (complete shipment)	Default status is full shipping		
Generate remaining order ?	Allows you to configure by default whether or not you want to generate a backorder for each shipment. You will have the possibility in each order to modify this information.		
Remaining order sate	You can choose a specific status for the balances that will have been generated. By default we select for you remaining order.		
Generate invoice ? (in general for B2B)	Often reserved for B2B mode you have the possibility to generate an invoice for the generated orders. This is also a default value. When creating your partial shipments you will be able to modify this value.




4. Back-Office usage

4.1. Management of orders and partial deliveries

Firstly, only orders that contain at least two products can be partially delivered. Indeed, if your order contains 1 and only 1 product it is not possible to deliver the order partially.

We now invite you to go to the list of commands (Commands tab> Orders) and choose a command that contains several products.




You will see in this screen the list of products that can be delivered.

You can specify:

- the number of products you want to deliver,
- · a tracking number
- Whether or not you choose to create an order with the undelivered products (Remember this option is configurable in the general
 configuration of the module).

Here we chose not to separate the command, however we could very well be we would then have had this screen:




4.1.1 Create a partial shipment with no order remaining

There are therefore two notions of partial shipment:

- Creation of a partial delivery with no order remaining. This means that we do not create a new order and therefore the order will go into partial shipment status with the list of delivered products.
- Creation of partial delivery with order balance

We are interested here in the first point. When creating the delivery simply put the option "Separate this command and generate a rest of command?" on NO.

You will generate your delivery and you will see all the deliveries made for this order.



4.1.2 Create partial delivery with remaining order

In this configuration everything is totally different.

You have two types of commands:

- · Orders billed and paid
- · Unbilled and unpaid orders

4.1.2.1 Orders billed and paid

We decide to make a rest of the order on an order invoiced and paid. Normally, you are not supposed to check the box to generate a new invoice since a payment = an invoice. However for X or Y reason you might be required to generate a new invoice.

If you choose the latter option, we will modify the initial invoice to deduct the amounts of the remaining order so that the sum of your two invoices corresponds to the total amount paid by the customer.

Now, if you want to keep the initial invoice, each of the remaining orders will resume the entire order initially passed.

4.1.2.2 Unbilled and unpaid orders

In this specific case, there is no need to ask questions when creating a rest of order. There is necessarily, the creation of a new invoice that will correspond to the remaining order. Indeed, no accounting document exists so we can not modify an existing invoice. So we will create as many accounting documents as there are backorders.

For all remaining orders you will get a list of related orders at the bottom of your order.



4.2 Email Alert

If you have chosen to alert your customer to each change of his order your customer will receive a detail of each shipment with attachment the delivery note associated with the shipment:



Your access customer has tracked shipments of his order from his customer account interface and then "Order history".

When clicking on "Details" your customer will have access to the delivery information if you have used our Partial Shipment module - Remaining order.

It will thus have the possibility to download the Delivery note of each shipment and to follow the parcel by simply clicking on the tracking number that you will have given.
