FOLLOW THE GUIDE!

The first thing to do is to configure some general settings. To do this, after installing the module, click the Module Configuration button. In the first tab, you have the general settings. Choose the number of days of preparation you need, indicate how long a command takes to be prepared, how much extra time it takes for a command with one or more products out of stock, an optional reason, its position into the cart and finally whether to display the time delivery on the product pages or not. Save before moving on.

Now, you have to add your rules. In the second tab, click to add a rule, select your carrier, zone, days of delivery of your carrier and the minimum and maximum number of days for the package to be delivered. Finally, indicate the maximum order time of the day so that the order is counted as a preparation day. If the order is placed after this time, one delivery day will be added.

You can now go to your shop to test!

If you wish, you can add dates without delivery and/or without preparation time. For example, if Christmas Day falls on a usual weekday, you can specify it in the module so that it does not count as a day of delivery and/or preparation.

To do this, simply select the carrier, the area, the date and if you do not want delivery and/or preparation time. When displayed on your store, calculating dates take into account the exceptions that you complete.

F.A.Q
